PRIMARY ADMISSION APPLICATIONS CLOSING DATE - TUESDAY 15th JANUARY 2019

Please note that if you have a child or know someone who has, who will be 4 years of age before 31 August 2019 then time is running out to apply for a primary school place.

This is a national statutory deadline and late applications will not be dealt with alongside those which have been received by 15th January 2019. Late applicants may therefore be disadvantaged in terms of receiving an offer for one of your preferred primary schools. **You need to apply online at www.lancashire.gov.uk**. It is not enough to just complete the school's supplementary form. If in doubt, see Mrs. Mac.
